## Two Day Seminar on "Life & Contribution of Shaikh-ul Aalam (R.A)" held.

Markaz-i Noor, Centre for Shaikh-ul Aalam Studies organized two day seminar on "Life & Contribution of Alamdar-i Kashmir Shaikh Noor-ud Din Noorani<sup>(R.A)"</sup> on 6-7<sup>th</sup> December 2012.
