

Conference held at Rohmu, Pulwama

On 30th April, 2011 Markaz-i Noor, Shaikh-ul Aalam Chair organized one day conference on “Life and Teachings of Saint Hazrat Ruma Reshi^(RA)” at Rohmu, Pulwama, a village believed to have been founded by this Hazrat Ruma Reshi^(RA).
