Meeting of Advisory Committee

Some other important decisions were also taken during the meeting which constitute translation of Reshinams, conduct of programmes in collaboration with academic and cultural organisations, launching of an independent website, establishment of cultural centre, publication of journal Alamadar, development of infrastructure, conduct of out-reach programmes, production of a film on multidimensional personality of Shaikh-ul Aalam, establishment of a folklore museum, organising an exhibition, installation of hoardings with support of SRC, University of Kashmir. Matters regarding budget and finance of the Centre were also discussed and certain decisions were taken up. The decisions were confirmed and approved by the Vice- Chancellor, University of Kashmir.
