Syllabus for PhD programme

Paper I: Research Methodology in Humanities
(English, Kashmiri and Urdu)

Course Objectives: The Research Methodology course developed by Shaikh-ul Aalam Centre for Multidisciplinary Studies seeks to cater to PhD students of Humanities based at the Centre to help them acquire critical knowledge and understanding of various aspects related to research methods, besides focusing on ethical issues involved in the research process. The course involves two components that are focused around research techniques, besides engaging students on the meaning and scope of research in Humanities in a broader sense.
